INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP of the BBKA is designed to accommodate those who are interested in furthering the objectives of the BBKA and accessing directly the benefits of such membership.

Members receive a free copy of the BBKA Year Book each year and a monthly copy of BBKA News. They also receive copies of any leaflets produced in the year and information we receive from the National Bee Unit. Individual membership is open to any beekeeper, subject to confirmation by the executive committee. UK members are covered by the BBKA third party public liability and product liability insurance – the details are on the BBKA website.
