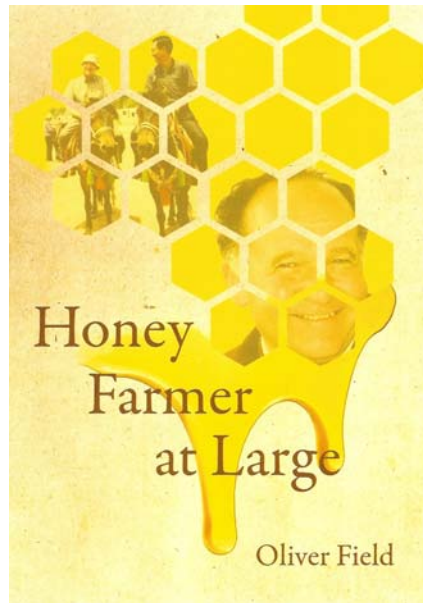


NEW BOOK FROM IBRA



Honey Farmer at Large by Oliver Field published by IBRA, Cardiff in 2009, 92 pages soft back, £5.00 plus postage and packing.

Oliver Field has been involved with honey bees since boyhood first keeping a few hives in his early twenties and then being kept by bees for the rest of his life! At one point he was bee farming as many as a thousand hives. He has already written one autobiographical book about his experiences – *Honey by the ton*.

In this new book he tells of his adventures in Shetland, Ethiopia, Cameroon, Yemen and Mongolia. It is not just about bees, although they play a significant role, but gives insights into human nature and is a most enjoyable read, full of wry humour and pertinent comment. It contains coloured illustrations.

He has also been interested in rearing queen bees for almost 40 years and recently put his thoughts into an informative little booklet *Field notes on queen rearing*.

Oliver lives, with his wife Pat, in Hampshire and continues to keep a lively interest in Field Honey Farms now managed by his son, Robert.
